Choose a character in the novel who deceives others. Write an essay in which you analyze the motives for the character's deceptions and discuss how the deception contributes to the meaning of the work as a whole.

Criteria:

1. Length
 - Quality over quantity: Your essay must contain an introduction, body paragraphs, and a closing. Make sure you include several examples from the novel to support your thesis. The thesis should be present in the introduction.
